



The Navy has leaseholds and easements for 8,172 acres. On the Mānā Plain, other entities hold their own leases with the state for agriculture. The easement lands are used passively by the Navy for Anti-Terrorism/Force Protection and safety arcs.

The Navy use of these state lands is required to maintain technological and safety capabilities supporting PMRF training and testing. Navy training and testing operations do not occur on these state lands.

NASA currently has leaseholds and easements for 23 acres of state land for operations at Kōke'e Park Geophysical Observatory.

For NASA, these state lands are critical to maintain data collection efforts of global significance.

NASA issued the Navy a Use Permit in 2016 for portions of KPGO to conduct radar, telemetry, and communications services in support of PMRF operations.
